Please ring (03) 9249 8822 for an appointment. Every effort will be made to accommodate your preferred time and GP. Alternative methods include, booking online on our website, or downloading our app.

Appointments are 15 minutes in duration. Longer consultation times are available; if you require completion of forms, have complex or severe issues to discuss or need a procedure of any kind, including a Pap smear or implanon, then please ask our receptionists about booking some extra time. If you or a family member requires an interpreter service, please let us know when you make the appointment.

Both South Yarra Medical and Hawthorn Medical are affiliated with Richmond Medical, some of our doctors work at both practices. Our database is shared between these locations, and therefore patient records can be accessed via both practices.

Care outside normal opening hours

Out of hours emergency medical care can be obtained by contacting our locum service, *Doctor Doctor* on *13 26 60*, This service is bulk billed.

Telephone access

GPs are unable to be contacted during consultations unless specified arrangements have been made. In order to provide the best possible care, our GPs are unable to give advice over the phone. It is in the best interest of the patient to make an appointment to see a GP.

During business hours patients may speak to our Practice Nurse, however specific details will not be provided unless consent is given from the provider.

Scripts and referrals to specialists without appointments:

To maintain quality healthcare service, a consultation with the doctor is required to determine the appropriateness of each request for referral or prescription, even if it is an ongoing concern.

Only under exceptional circumstances will an urgent script or referral be provided. The provider may charge a non-rebateable fee of \$20 + GST at their discretion.

Immunisations

Childhood vaccines are bulkbilled during the week with a valid Medicare card. Weekend visits attract the standard rate.

Travel vaccines include Hepatitis A + B, Typhoid, Polio, Tetanus and many others. Our practice is accredited to provide *Yellow Fever* Vaccination, which is required for Africa and South America.
